


The Fundamental Relations




- (1) Prevents Social Collapse – Free markets show no mercy. Massive dislocations can occur as unproductive companies are punished. Workers bargain in desperation. Conditions lead to theft, sabotage and revolution. Entitlement allows the free market to function without causing harm.
- (2) Spawns New Enterprise – Entitlement spawns new business in formerly poor and lower-middle class neighborhoods. Domestic workers are financially able to fill low paying jobs.
- (3) Precondition – Deregulation drives down the cost of the entitlements, healthcare costs in particular. The free market is needed to generate sufficient productivity to support the entitlements through either the child-bearing fund and/or taxation.
- (4) Funds – Reproductive control funds entitlement and takes the burden off taxpayers.

- (5) Prevents Social Collapse – Universal entitlement creates a society where children add to the wealth of a household. If the household has little wealth to begin with, children would be treated as income. Without reproductive control to both fund entitlement and prevent unlimited births, resources would be depleted, taxpayers would rebel, and reactionary forces would lead us to barbarism.
- (6) Prevents Genocide – By using market forces and projected future population needs to determine what constitutes a fully-funded child-bearing account, and by using the market mechanism of funding a child-bearing account, reproduction control is taken away from politicians and bureaucrats, who might base decisions of who could reproduce on arbitrary whims, ethnic loyalties, personal and popular prejudices.
- (7) Precondition – Entitlement is a precondition for any kind of reproductive control. Without entitlement, children provide the impoverished with many of the same necessities as in pre-modern times, such as income, social security, and safety. Likewise, without entitlement, a parent cannot always afford to stay home and provide care for the child. Entitlement is the engine that allows for both an increase and decrease in population.


These seven relations are fundamental to AFFEERCE. In addition to the three pillars, are two voluntary consequences of AFFEERCE society; alternative families and enlightenment. The economic pressure for alternative families is too great to assume that they would not naturally arise, although pair-bonding within those families is likely to be the norm for some time to come. AFFEERCE enlightenment, on the other hand, is a private affair. Each of us is free to accept or reject “natural truth,” and interpret natural truth in our own way. Whether one chooses to embrace the new value on human life, the value of universal entitlement, the new possibilities of free time and its effect on culture and spirituality, the values of honesty and justice, or the more radical proposition that objectivism and subjectivism are also synthesized in the philosophy of science, is strictly a personal choice. The diagrams show how alternative families and enlightenment are related to the AFFEERCE foundations.

The Family Relations



- (8) Supports Entrepreneurs – Large families allow some members to take on risk and provide a greater division of labor for startups.
- (9) Creates Economy of Scale – Each additional family member allows a more efficient use for the total housing, food and sundry entitlements, thereby creating wealth.
- (10) Competitive Advantage – Universal entitlement enables family business to compete with big business by making low wages practical.
- (11) Raising Funds – Large families can pool their resources to fund children, even if individual incomes are small.

(12) Humanistic Markets – The greatest wealth is a loving family and children. No love or fetishism of commodities which lose value in a deflationary economy. Honesty and concern for the customer is good business and good for the soul.

(13) Allows Spiritual Development – Universal entitlement allows as much time as needed for people to engage in prayer, meditation, art, education, and spiritual growth.

(14) Reproductive Control – Enlightenment Contradiction – The fundamental contradiction between reproductive control and enlightenment is the embodiment of Gödel’s proof that no system can be both consistent and complete. A free society must never forget the cost to spiritual wholeness and parental freedom that follows from requiring payment for having children. Yet spiritual wholeness is enhanced when material accumulation is directed toward

something decidedly non-material and when considering the enhanced freedom of the child in a level playing field. We can only hope that the dynamic of this contradiction pushes mankind toward increased productivity and new frontiers in an effort to drive the cost of reproduction to zero.
